Open letter to the press, educational establishments and local authorities.

It is with considerable alarm that we learn of people continuing to enter the water at Bawsey Country Park, King's Lynn.

It is also disheartening that safety signs have again been attacked by vandals and that the site is being used as an open toilet.

As the landowner, we are working with the community to deliver a long term sustainable solution.

In the meantime, we will ensure all reasonable steps are taken to have the damage repaired. We will also continue to monitor the site as and when operational demands allow.

We cannot however 'police' the park on a regular basis.

We urgently request your support for a campaign to raise the awareness of the dangers posed by flooded quarry sites.

Last summer two people died at Bawsey, we do not want further deaths.

Please help to spread these messages in any way you can.
