MILL DROVE PLANNING APPLICATION REFUSED

The recent planning application for an inert waste recycling facility and associated infrastructure in Mill Drove, Blackborough End was refused by Norfolk County Council on 5 August.

The Notice of Refusal set out four main reasons for the decision, principally that the application was not consistent with current planning policies and that insufficient information had been provided about amenity impacts, including noise impacts.

The applicant has six months in which to appeal to the Secretary of State.

East Winch Parish Council meeting 6th September 2021

The meeting was attended by both Mr de Whalley, Borough Councillor and Mr Moriarty, County Councillor.

A complaint was made about the state of the right of way from East Winch to Middleton Towers and the inertia of NCC, which is responsible for ensuring that landowners maintain public footpaths to a good standard. The complainant also suggested that the Parish Council thanks Mr R Wilson for opening a pathway to the public during lockdown, to the benefit of many in the village. Cllr Moriarty and the Parish Council will contact NCC.

Cllr Moriarty and Nell Steele reported on the recent Sibelco liaison meeting. Cllr Moriarty said he'd be pressing the company to find out what they do for the community, which he thinks they have largely ignored. The planning application for the extension of the Grandcourt Farm site (min 40), made in 2018, should finally be considered by NCC in November.

Cllr Moriarty confirmed that food bins were being emptied again and furthermore, that there is a prize for a lucky food bin user!

The Borough Council (Amanda Driver) is making Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) grants of up to £10,000 for community projects, including play areas and drainage. There's also a Community Grant Scheme of up to £2000 per year. It was thought likely that applications for either grant could be made by local societies and didn't necessarily come via the Parish Council.

A planning application along the main road in West Bilney was discussed, relating to drainage. The Parish Council will ask the Planning Dept to look into that aspect of the application.

The Council are still anxious to get a road up to Ashwick Rd, but it will cost £45,000. However, we can apply for the CIL grant, Cllr Moriarty said it was a priority and he would give the money available to him, and if NCC Partnership Plan operates, which we won't know for until the winter, we may get help from that too. So we are hopeful!

The next Parish Council meeting will take place at 7.30 on Monday, 1st November.

Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios event is back this year, but has moved from Spring to Autumn. The scheme is a celebration of the county's artists and their achievements, when they open their doors to the public to exhibit, sell and talk about their work.



Visitors have the opportunity to meet the makers, see how work is made, and to buy or commission original pieces.



Life

As summer passes into autumn, many churches celebrate the fruitful end of one farming year with Harvest Festivals. It also marks the start of new life as crops are already being sown as part of the annual farming cycle.

As a young lad, attending an evening Harvest Festival service was magical and has left an enduring memory of churches lit by the glow of candles and oil lamps, no electricity in those days. The congregation was mainly made up of farmers and the workers who had brought the harvest home. The church was bedecked with fresh farm and garden produce which were distributed to good causes after the service.

As part of those memories, one harvest hymn, "Come ye thankful people come" has stayed in my memory over the years. For me, it not only encompasses life on an annual basis but also life in all its stages including all the difficulties in between.

The author of the "Come ye thankful people come", Henry Alford, the son of a Rector, clearly captured life in its words. It is printed below as a reminder and to provide the opportunity to reflect on the content.

Come, ye thankful people, come,
Raise the song of harvest-home!
All is safely gathered in,
Ere the winter storms begin:
God our Maker doth provide
For our wants to be supplied;
Come to God's own temple, come,
Raise the song of harvest-home!

We ourselves are God's own field,
Fruit unto His praise to yield;
Wheat and tares together sown
Unto joy or sorrow grown.
First the blade and then the ear,
Then the full corn shall appear;
Grant, O Harvest Lord, that we
Wholesome grain and pure may be.

For the Lord our God shall come,
And shall take His harvest home;
From His field shall purge away
All that doth offend that day:
Give His angels charge at last
In the fire the tares to cast;
But the fruitful ears to store
In His garner evermore.

Then, thou Church triumphant, come,
Bring the song of harvest-home;
All are safely gathered in,
Free from sorrow, free from sin,
There, for ever purified,
In God's garner to abide;
Come, ten thousand angels, come,
Raise the glorious harvest-home!

Over the last 50 years, the need for more efficient food production, has resulted in a huge reduction in the number of farms, farmers and those that work on the farms attending harvest festivals. The congregations are now mainly made up of a cross section of parishioners from many walks of life.

In organising harvest festivals, churches now accept donations of food in tins, jars and long life wrapping which are distributed to food banks to help those who are struggling to feed their families.

The spirit of harvest is still very much alive in the community and in "God's own field".

CHOOSE LIFE! ACT NOW!

It has been clear for decades that the earth's climate is changing, but **human actions still have the potential to determine the future course of climate** - though some changes, such as the rising of sea level, cannot be reversed. This is the view of the International Panel on Climate Change.

The IPCC is the United Nations body for assessing the science related to climate change. Its most recent report, by scientists from around the world, reveals climate change is already affecting every region on earth in multiple ways and it is happening faster and intensifying. Life threatening events abound. We hear of floods in Germany, record breaking temperatures in Siberia, wild-fires in America and Australia, ice melting in the Arctic and Antarctic, mudslides in South America and Asia, crop failures and famines in Africa - the list goes on and on.

In Glasgow this autumn the UK will host COP 26, the 26th UN Climate Change Conference. It will bring together heads of state, climate experts and non-governmental organizations to agree on co-ordinated action to tackle climate change. Sadly, the pledges made at COP 21 in Paris in 2015 to control global temperature rise have not been kept, with some countries reneging on the treaty signed then by 196 nations, so we may find ourselves asking, "Will COP 26 make a difference?"

Strong and sustained reductions in emissions of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases **would** limit climate change. Benefits for air quality would come quickly, but it could take 20-30 years to see global temperatures stabilize.

Whether climate change is limited will depend on our choices now. It will not depend only on choices and pledges for the future made by governments at COP meetings, but on the choices and actions we as individuals worldwide make in our personal and working lives - choices that will not only affect each of us, but generations to come.

What can you and I do here in West Norfolk to limit climate change? We can pray and commit ourselves to action. Is it just a case of putting on an extra jumper rather than turning up the heat, using the car less, walking, cycling or using public transport where available and modifying our diet? Do we know what difference these actions would make? A friend has pointed me to the website of Giki, (Get Informed, Know your Impact) so that I can find out my carbon footprint. I haven't done so yet - but the choices we make now will affect life for us all.

WILDLIFE GARDEN


We returned to RSPCA East Winch as volunteer gardeners in September after last working on the garden in October 2019 when it was starting to take shape and looking pretty good.






